Code of Ethics



- **1**. Respite for Change staff and volunteers are concerned with exposing and addressing sin, not with pleasing the *person receiving ministry*.
- **2**. Respite for Change believes *repentance is* the foundation for effective Deliverance ministry (DM)
- **3**. Respite for Change ensures the person receiving Deliverance ministry understands their trust is in Jesus alone for their healing and deliverance.
- **4**. Respite for Change makes it clear to the person receiving ministry that deliverance will be a *process* and not a one-time event.
- **5**. Respite for Change ensures that the person receiving ministry understands that as they embark on the *deliverance process*, the intensity and frequency of the spiritual attacks in their life will likely increase.

- **6**. Respite for Change ensures the person receiving ministry understands the *Demonic Reentry Clause* (Matthew 12:43-45).
- **7**. Respite for Change ensures that the person receiving deliverance ministry understands the *Formula for Freedom* (James 4:7)
- **8**. Respite for Change staff and volunteers never disparage, malign or argue with anyone who does not believe in deliverance as we do. At R4C, we conduct inner healing and we drive out evil as Jesus did.
- **9**. Respite for change staff or volunteers does not disparage, malign, or speak ill of other ministries of deliverance, especially ones that operate using different models or paradigms.
- **10**. Respite for Change staff and volunteers treats the person receiving ministry with gentleness, patience, dignity, love, and without bias.
